At a time when we can observe important movements of extremist and violent radicalisation in Europe, our project "Start on the Street" aims to develop an experimental methodology using street sports practices and/or city stadium sports to prevent primary radicalisation phenomena among Young people aged 15 to 25 years old.

We wish to demonstrate that sport can play a role in preventing this process through a better integration of young people in society. The sports and cultural activities put in place will give us the opportunity to defend the fundamental principles of social cohesion, inclusion and respect.

From September 2021 to June 2022 :

- youth mobilization and communication
- weekly urban sports and cultural events
- citizenship education and socio-professional support
- organizing a START ON THE STREET event in the heart of the neighborhood

Specific communication tools will be provided in English and/or in the language of the countries concerned.



EVALUATION OF THE PROJECT - 2022

3

- 3 workshops in Paris (november 2021, january and may 2022) bringing together actors in the field (2 per territory) : feedback and exchange of best practices.
- A European scientific council, representative of all stakeholders
- A team of "sport and radicalization" specialists who will visit all the different sites

- Final seminar in Paris (may / june 2022) : presentation of results to all stakeholders
- Publication of a methodological guide to scale up the project
